The following changes will take place effective Monday, October 19, 2020:

## PED MALL AND DELI USE BY GUESTS AND CAREGIVERS:

- Guests and caregivers may use the Ped Mall and the Deli
- No guests under the age of 18
- No more than 2 guests at any time
- Guests are NOT allowed in The Gardenia, pool, fitness center, or any other common areas or to use any other amenities

## BEVERAGE SERVICE AT THE DELI:

Beverage service will end at 1pm when the Deli closes, due to limited usage

## PLATES AND FLATWARE AT DELI:

- Plates and flatware wrapped in napkins will be available for breakfast and lunch at the Deli for those eating in the Ped Mall
- To-go containers will continue to be available for those eating elsewhere
- Please inform the cashier if you will be eating in the Ped Mall or wish to have it to-go
- Condiments will be available in single-serve portions from the Deli

The following change will be effective Monday, November 2:

## GUEST ROOMS:

- Guest rooms may be reserved starting October 19 for stays starting November 2
- Guest room reservation policy is still in effect (Resident Handbook)
- No more than 2 guests per Resident unit are allowed in the building
- Guests must be 18 years old or older
- Guests must complete the health check prior to entering the guest rooms
- Guests and caregivers may use the Ped Mall and the Deli
- Guests are NOT allowed in The Gardenia, pool, fitness center, or any other common areas or to use any other amenities.

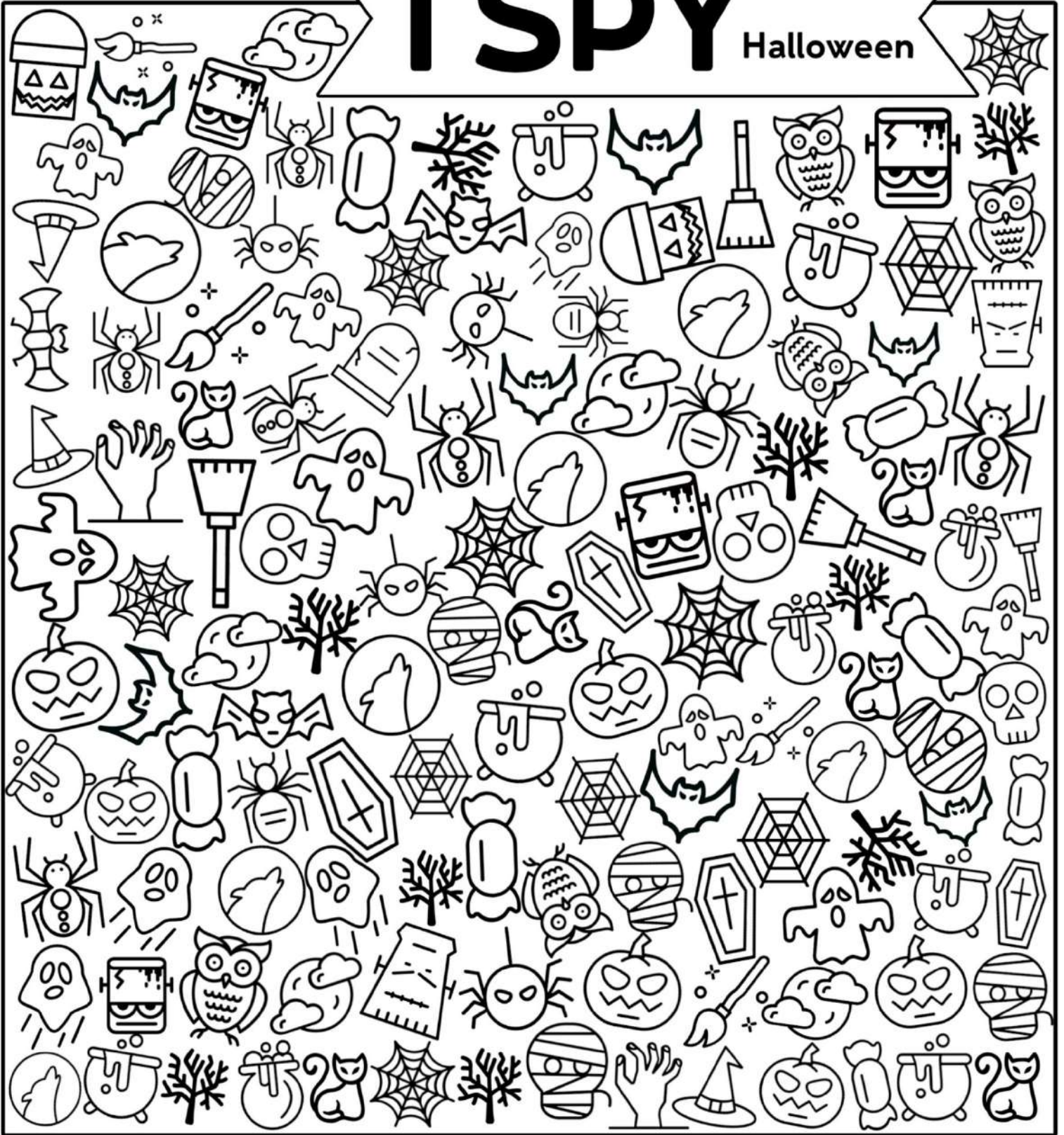
